# Why ban SINGLE-USE CARRY-OUT plastic bags?

To reduce litter, protect the environment, and remove hard-to-recycle bags from our waste system.

What is Glen Rock's Regulation for SINGLE-USE CARRY-OUT Plastic bags?

No retail or food service establishment shall provide to any customer a single-use plastic carryout bag.



### When does it begin?

What types of bags are banned? SINGLE-USE CARRY-OUT

Plastic Bags...

GET DY! JANUARY

It begins on January 1, 2020.

...this means any THIN bag made predominantly of plastic derived from either petroleum or biologically based sources, including bags that are compostable or biodegradable.

#### What bags ARE allowed?

All bags used INSIDE of the store are allowed such as bags for:











baked goods /prescription drugs / loose produce / potted plants & cut flowers / garbage & yard waste.



### Can I bring my own bags?

Yes, customers can and are encouraged to bring any type of bag to use.

### Will retailers provide reusable bags or recyclable paper bags?

All retail and food service establishments may make available to customers, for a fee of at least \$0.10, reusable bags or recyclable paper bags. Small paper bags (less than 8"x16") may be made available for free.
