- 65 total teams + 16 travel teams (spring and summer);
- chartered member of Little League, District 4;
- we use all baseball/softball fields in town; plus the turf when it will be available.
- Monthly report:
 - opening day was a success; we had a good turnout for our annual parade;
 - games are underway and going well (aside from the weather);
 - we expect to continue to have a great spring season;
 - our next event is our All Star Saturday which will be Saturday, May 14th;

• our spring travel baseball teams have been playing for a few weeks as well and we just concluded tryouts for our travel softball teams.

Basketball (Youth): Ryan McNair

- We are a 501C3;

- Normal Update:
