#### **Unfinished Business:**

- Faber Field: The 5 tennis courts need updated rules to be posted by all courts, especially banning paid lessons during peak hours and on weekends
- A tennis/pickleball reservation system. See Director's report.
- Brooms and benches on tennis/pickleball courts (maybe a plastic bag drive like the dog park does for benches). No action taken.
- An additional gate between the front 2 and rear 3 tennis/pickleball courts in the corner where they meet is in the process of being implemented. Money to come out of the DPW funds.
- Racking system for pickleball during high use times. No action taken.
- Signage must be displayed by each gate entry to the turf field to show what is allowed: players, feet, blankets, and water bottles including what is not allowed: chairs, shade tents, coolers, any food, gum, oranges. Discussion is on going.
- The lightning alarm at the pool is not in sync with Upper Faber. The system must be the same throughout the Borough. This is being examined.

• No Field Hockey will be played; turn out was too low to justify the program.

DPW: Bob Buono:

- NJ Transit and the Borough of GR were in a two (2) month venture to repair the culvert by the tennis/pickleball/basketball courts to excavate, drain and add screening to the area to reduce/eliminate flooding onto the courts.
- *No Litter* signs were put up at the BB courts/tennis/pickleball courts to help participants comply with the rules of the courts. Bob suggested asking the police to come over and speak with the basketball players as they are not in compliance. The area looks terrible every morning.
- Playgrounds have been mulched and are good for a few years. A special mulch must be used.
- A H2O fountain was installed at Faber, it is water bottle compliant.
- More FB equipment has been received for the turf field.
