April 23, 2019

A public meeting of the Glen Rock Board of Health was held in the conference room of the Municipal Building on Tuesday April 23, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 7:42p.m.

A motion to accept the minutes of the March 26, 2019 meetings was made by Terry Andretta and seconded by Dr. Sapienza. All were in favor.

REPORTS

The Board reviewed the report submitted by Marjorie Vanacore and Steven Salerno. Due to the absence of both health inspectors at the last meeting the Board reviewed the reports for February and March. The issue of pests control is very prevalent, and Steven explained the inspection protocols. The Board all agreed that more frequent inspections should be performed as well as follow-ups, Mr. Brown stated that there should be stricter requirements for establishments and elevated fines for repeat offenders, all were in favor. Steven replied that fines range from \$50-\$1000 and are determined at the county level. The Board also agreed to require business owners to use a licensed pest control companies and to revisit King Wok II, Tani and Glen Rock Inn for reinspection. Mrs. Bernstein commented that the Board can make changes to the Ordinance to reflect stricter code enforcement. The Nursing reports were also reviewed and discussed. To date 928 dogs and 182 cats have licensed, a list of all unlicensed pets was turned over to Tyco for summons to be issued.

OLD BUSINESS

The Board discussed the Ordinance banning plastic bags which will go into effect on January 1st. Council Member Kreibich stated the Environmental Commission will be providing education on the Ordinance. She also mentioned there are exceptions and the reception of business owners is very good. The Second Sundays Community Market will be beginning June 9th and continue into October, Steven or Marjorie will be performing inspections every month. Mr. Brown references an article on the ongoing possibility of Marijuana legalization in the State. The article states the Senate will be putting in on the agenda next month for a vote.

NEW BUSINESS

Mrs. Bernstein stated that the County is offering free lead screenings for children, a poster will be on the community bulletin board and posted on the Borough's website. Mrs. Bernstein also stated that May is mental health awareness month and the County is holding courses throughout May. The Board was reminded to file their financial disclosures. Council Member Kreibich also reminded everyone that Saturday April 27th is Community Clean-up with registration available on the website

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned by Suzanne McCullough and seconded by Dr. Sapienza at 8:50p.m. All were in favor.

The next meeting has been scheduled for May 21, 2019 at 7:30 p.m. in the conference room of the municipal building.
