A public meeting of the Glen Rock Board of Health was held in the conference room of the Municipal Building on Tuesday September 24, 2019. The meeting was called to order at 7:32p.m.

A motion to accept the minutes of the May 21,2019 and June 25, 2019 meetings was made by Suzanne McCullough and seconded Marilyn Bernstein. All were in favor.

**REPORTS**

The Board reviewed the reports submitted by Marjorie Vanacore, Steven Salerno and Lisa Nassor for June, July and August. While reviewing the reports Mrs. Vanacore addressed rodent issues on residential properties during construction and she explained the construction official requires abatement before construction begins and if rodents are an issue on other private properties it is the property owners responsibility. The Nursing reports were also reviewed and discussed.

**OLD BUSINESS**

Ginine Cilenti from the Diabetes Foundation reviewed possible events for Diabetes Awareness Month in November. During discussions it was determined that November 11<sup>th</sup> -17<sup>th</sup> would be a good time to have restaurant week with a possible event at Glen Courts and on November 17<sup>th</sup> the foundation will be hosting an event at the Arboretum. The Board voted in favor of the Diabetes Foundation using the Borough's logo for a postcard mailing. The Board then discussed guidelines and possible fines that would be associated with a new pest control ordinance. Mr. Brown requested the County to survey all food establishments to determine how many have a preventative pest control service in place. Mrs. Vanacore stated the County has an investigator that will go to each establishment and review their pest control service.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

The Board discussed that currently there are two open positions on the Board due to the formal resignation of Dr. Renner. It was agreed upon by the Board that the flu clinic will be held on October 23<sup>rd</sup>. The vaccines will be supplied by the County and administered by Valley Nurses. Mrs. Bernstein stated the in the Borough's contract with the County states they can also administer vaccines. The contracts will be reviewed to compare services for next year as they are received by the Board. Plans for Stone and Rail were reviewed for proposed outdoor seating. Mrs. Vancore will make suggestions and submit them to the Building Department.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned by Wayne Brown and seconded by Terry Andretta at 9:06 p.m. All were in favor.
