## BOROUGH COUNCIL

## VOTER REGISTRATION

Glen Rock residents may register at the Borough Clerk's office any business day from 8:30am to 4:30pm. To be eligible to vote, a resident must have lived in Glen Rock a minimum of 21 days and be a U.S. citizen 18 years of age on or before the election.

## TAX PAYMENT

Tax bills are mailed to residents in July. Quarterly taxes are due February 1, May 1, August 1 and November 1. In addition to the traditional modes of payment, cash or check at the Tax Window, checks sent through the mail or dropped in our Borough Mailbox; taxpayers are now being offered the ability to make payments in two more ways: pay by ACH from a bank account (a \$2 convenience fee will apply); pay by credit card (a 2.4% convenience fee will apply) through the ONLINE TAX PAYMENTS link on the Borough Website. The Borough provides a ten day grace period, after which, interest is charged from the first day of the month in which the payments are due.

## DOG AND CAT LICENSES

The State of New Jersey requires that a license be obtained for dogs/cats age 7 months and older. A rabies vaccination certificate valid through November 1 of the current year is required in order to obtain a license. The license fee is \$15

for spayed/neutered pets and \$20 otherwise. Annual rabies vaccination clinic sponsored by the Glen Rock Board of Health is held on January 14, 2020. Pet licenses must be renewed by January 31, 2020 to avoid a \$10 late fee per pet.

## SENIORS

**Senior Shuttle** A free service that provides transportation for Glen Rock seniors. The shuttle has a set weekly schedule that includes local grocery stores and shopping centers. It is also available to help residents get to doctors' appointments. The shuttle begins picking up residents at Glen Courts at 9:30am on scheduled shopping days (11:00am for the Mall). Residents who do not live at Glen Courts can call 201-670-3956 option 1 to arrange pick up at their residence.



## Help Glen Rock Reduce Our Trash

Reducing our trash reduces our costs & helps the environment. Please help reduce our costs and our carbon footprint by reusing, donating and recycling more, and consider backyard composting and "leaving your leaves."

### HOUSEHOLD REAR YARD GARBAGE COLLECTION

Regular pick up twice a week from the rear yards. **Please check the website for schedule changes due to holidays or inclement weather.** Pickup service includes all waste, animal, fish, fowl, fruit, and vegetable matter resulting from food consumption. See map for routes.

**NORTH/WEST Route: Monday & Thursday**

**SOUTH/EAST Route: Tuesday & Friday**

- All material must be placed in a plastic bag in closed plastic or metal containers (no larger than 30 gallons) by 6:00am.
- Animal waste should be placed in heavy plastic bags and disposed of weekly.
- Please advise the Sanitation Department if you change the location of your garbage containers.
- Residents are required to shovel a path in snow or ice to the location of your garbage containers to allow access.
- **If your garbage pick-up is missed, call the DPW at 201-670-3980.**

### CURBSIDE PICKUP RUBBISH AND METAL

#### Disposing Household Rubbish/Bulk Trash:

- Monthly curbside pickup of bulky household materials such as appliances, furnishings, metal and household equipment that cannot be disposed of in rear-yard garbage collection.
- Rubbish and metal collection is on designated Wednesdays once a month, by residential area.

- Place rubbish and metal at the curb after 7:00pm Tuesday evening and before 6:00am Wednesday morning on scheduled pickup days.
- Rubbish must be in plastic bags, bundled or securely tied, for easy handling and to prevent blowing and littering.
- The Borough will not pick up building and construction materials, fire damaged materials, vehicular parts and propane tanks.
- Hazardous materials can be disposed of several times via Bergen Community Utilities Authority. [www.bcua.org](http://www.bcua.org) or 201-641-2552.

### COMPOST FACILITY 350 DOREMUS AVE

- Vegetative waste such as grass clippings, branches etc are accepted at the compost facility during operating hours, but not picked up curbside except during Spring Clean Up dates. Please see Borough website for additional information.
- Woodchips and mulch are available for resident use for free, as supplies are available.
- Stickers for access to the compost facility are mailed to residents with their annual tax bills. Additional stickers may be obtained at Borough Hall.

### A MESSAGE FROM THE GLEN ROCK ENVIRONMENTAL COMMISSION

**REMINDER: Starting January 1, 2020,** Glen Rock businesses will no longer provide single-use thin plastic bags at checkout, and will charge a fee of at least 10 cents for any reusable or paper checkout

bags that they provide. Small paper bags (such as for prescriptions, bagels, or other small items) and thin plastic bags used within a store (such as produce bags) may still be provided for free. Glen Rockers are encouraged to bring their own reusable bags when they shop, and to shop local to support our Glen Rock businesses! ### AUTOMATIC SPRINKLERS REMINDER

#### Stage II Water Schedule in Effect in Glen Rock (for Lawns, Shrubs, and Gardens)

- Days: Odd numbered addresses may water only on Tuesdays and Saturdays, even numbered addresses may water only on Wednesdays and Sundays Watering using a hand held hose or drip irrigation is allowed on any day.
- Hours: All watering should be done during the cool times of the day, before 10:00am and after 6:00pm, and not during rainfall.





### Non-Emergency 201-652-3800

Any situation where emergency services personnel are needed but there is no immediate danger to life or property.

- Minor motor vehicle accident (no injury)
- Past incidents of theft or vandalism
- Non-violent disputes
- Noise complaints (loud parties, etc.)
- Weather and road related conditions
- Parking complaints
- Keys locked in vehicle (no child inside)
- Overnight parking requests
- Barking dogs or stray animals
- Public works emergencies after normal DPW hours
